One stage

- Per le proposte in una fase è necessario inviare la proposta completa (sez. 1. Excellence, 2. Impact e 3. Implementation)
- La proposta non deve eccedere le 70 pp.

Two stage

- Nelle proposte in due fasi è necessario compilare soltanto la cover page e la sez. 1 e parte della sez. 2 (impatto atteso, ma non dissemination e communication)
- La proposta per la prima fase non deve eccedere le 15 pp.
- Non è necessario:
 - indicare tutti i partner che parteciperanno al progetto, ma solo rispettare i criteri di eleggibilità (3 partner da 3 stati membri o associati)
 - compilare la Ethics issues table
 - compilare il budget nel dettaglio, ma soltanto indicare il totale richiesto

Costi eleggibili

- Costi del personale
- Subcontratti
- Altri costi diretti (es. costi di viaggio, ammortamento, ecc.)
- Costi indiretti (25% dei costi diretti)

- Communication (art. 38) $\neq$ Dissemination (art. 29)
- Dissemination es. articoli scientifici e convegni)
- Maggior importanza alle *communication activities*
- Art. 38.1 del GA, obbligo di redarre un *Communication plan* e ad inserire work package per la comunicazione (o cmq a includere tali attività in altri WP)
- Promozione del progetto e dei risultati al di fuori della comunità di partner del progetto
- Comunicare il progetto in modo che sia comprensibile anche dai non-specialisti (es. media e pubblico)
- Informare in anticipo la CE/Agenzia circa le attività di comunicazione che si aspetta possano avere un impatto significativo sui media (art. 38 del GA)

Horizon 2020 - Grant Agreement

Art. 38 PROMOTING THE ACTION — VISIBILITY OF EU FUNDING

38.1 Communication activities by beneficiaries

“The **beneficiaries** must promote the action and its results, by providing **targeted** information to **multiple audiences** (including the media and the public) in a strategic and effective manner.” [...]

Horizon 2020 - Grant Agreement

Art. 38

[...] Before engaging in a **communication activity expected to have a major media impact**, the beneficiaries **must inform** the [Commission][Agency].

Horizon 2020 - Grant Agreement

Art. 29 DISSEMINATION OF RESULTS — OPEN ACCESS — VISIBILITY OF EU FUNDING

29.1 General obligation to disseminate results

“Unless it goes against their legitimate interests, **each beneficiary must** - as soon as possible - **‘disseminate’ its results** by disclosing them to the public by appropriate means (other than those resulting from protecting or exploiting the results), including in scientific publications (in any medium).” [...]
